Nancy Kempton, Adams County Treasurer, discussed the Board's interest in compromising \$1,800 in back taxes on a property at 903 Adams in Corning. She explained the process and timelines for such an occurrence. Consensus was favorable if the interested party moves forward but no votes were taken.

Following discussion, regarding a Secondary Roads Maintenance Supervisor Employment Contract, no votes were taken. Additional work will be done on the draft document.

Mullen moved, seconded by Peckham, to approve a Resolution for a FY 12/13 Interfund Operating Transfer of \$694,892 from Rural Services Basic Fund to Secondary Roads as budgeted. Ayes: Birt, Mullen, Peckham, McCarty, England. Nays: none. Motion carried and said Resolution was assigned #05082012 in the Resolution Book and is available for public inspection in the Auditor's Office.

Action regarding appointing a Board of Health member to fill a vacancy was tabled.

Action regarding SICOG's assistance programming was tabled pending receipt of information.

The Supervisors had a discussion regarding moving our website domain and making the county email addresses part of the domain. The item was tabled pending further information being provided.

Ben Mullen, Veterans Affairs Commission, appeared to ask for something in writing regarding a request for a timesheet review and sign off on hours worked by the Veteran's Affairs employee. No votes were taken.

The Supervisors had a discussion regarding their present ordinances and asked that the Department Heads review their respective sections. No votes were taken.

Carl Goodson, County Sanitarian, discussed an issue concerning a resident's delayed installation of a septic system and allowing him an extension to complete the project. No votes were taken.

Wes Ray, County Assessor, updated the Supervisors regarding legislative action that would impact tax revenues. No votes were taken.

A written monthly report from the Adams County Recorder was read and approved.

Written reports by the Supervisors were submitted as follows: Linda England – SICOG at 1:00 PM in Creston on May 1; Phyllis Mullen – RCD in Creston on May 3 at 6:30 PM and Main Street Iowa Awards in Des Moines on May 4 at 5:30 PM.
