

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, April 15, 2019 at 1:00 pm with the following members present: Merlin Dixon, Doug Birt, Leland Shipley, and Scott Akin. Corey Moore was absent. Also in attendance were: Bobbi Maynes, Nancy Barnes, Jamie Stargell, Al Peckham, Travis Paul, Andrew Knuth, Karl McCarty, Nancy Turner, Alan Johannes and Bart Knox. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Shipley. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the agenda for the day was read and approved. Birt moved, seconded by Akin to approve the minutes from April 8, 2019. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Conservation Director Travis Paul, along with Conservation board member Al Peckham, discussed the one bid received for the conservation director house. Paul asked the board to consider the amount the county is willing to put towards the new house.

Treasurer Nancy Barnes gave a county investment update.

Sheriff Alan Johannes discussed with the board an upcoming trial on the court schedule that is being moved to the county from another venue. He discussed the extra precautions being taken as well as informing department heads to increase their awareness during the trial.

Birt moved, seconded by Dixon to set a public hearing for the FY19 Budget Amendment on May 6, 2019, at 10:00 AM. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

The Board of Supervisors, under the authority of the 2019 Code of Iowa, formed a canvassing board to check the returns of the Special Election held on April 9, 2019. The findings, thereof, are recorded at length in Election Book #8 in the Adams County Auditor's Office as required by Section 50.27 of the 2019 Code of Iowa. Pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 50.22, 0 provisional ballots were received. Bobbi J. Baker-Maynes was declared elected to fill a vacancy for Supervisor District 5 for the remainder of the term ending January 2, 2021.
