

Placement of driveways and field entrances shall provide an adequate stopping sight distance as defined in AASHTO's "A Policy on Geometric Design of Highways and Streets," as shown in AASHTO's "Guidelines for Geometric Design of Very Low-Volume Local Roads (Average Daily Traffic (ADT)  $\leq$  400)."

All entrances will be a minimum width of 20 feet at the driving surface and will have side slopes of 6 to 1 on hard surface roads and 3 to 1 on all others with a minimum of 2 foot of cover.

It is the responsibility of the installer (Applicant, Owner, or Contractor) to call One Call for utility locations.

Owner may purchase culvert pipe for entrance at cost from Adams County Secondary Roads.

This application is good for 180 days.
