

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, March 27, 2012, with the following members answering roll call: Linda England, Karl McCarty, Phyllis Mullen, Jerry Peckham and Doug Birt. The meeting was called to order by the Chair. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Wendi Boswell's appearance was postponed. No votes were taken.

Mullen moved, seconded by McCarty, to approve a \$25,248 bid from Cornerstone Construction for 180LF of 4' sidewalk tear-out and replacement, 30LF of 8' sidewalk tear-out and replacement, curbs, 4 plastic drains, handicap ramp replacement, handicap inserts, steps, etc. around the courthouse perimeter Ayes: McCarty, Peckham, Birt, England, Mullen. Nays: none. Motion carried
