Following discussion, McCarty introduced, seconded by Mullen, a Resolution Notifying Each Owner and Each Person in the Possession or Control of Any Lands in Adams County of Their Responsibility to Cut, Burn or Otherwise Destroy all Noxious Weeds and authorize publishing said notice. Roll Call vote: Ayes; Peckham, Mullen, Birt, England, McCarty. Nays; none. Motion carried and said Resolution was assigned #04102012 in the Resolution Book.

The appointment of a Board of Health member to fill a vacancy was tabled.

The Supervisors reviewed a proposed agreement for involuntary admission services with Alegent Health. No votes were taken.

A written quarterly report from the Adams County Sheriff and a monthly report from the Adams County Recorder was read and approved.
