

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, June 26, 2012, with the following members answering roll call: Linda England, Karl McCarty, Phyllis Mullen, Jerry Peckham and Doug Birt. The meeting was called to order by the Chair. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Duane Golden discussed a response to Madison County Hospital correspondence regarding an unauthorized detox delinquent billing. No votes were taken.

To meet code requirements, McCarty moved, seconded by Mullen, to approve an additional \$1,100 for the courthouse handicap railings. Ayes: England, McCarty, Peckham, Mullen, Birt. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Supervisors reviewed and approved the final acceptance for the rock resurfacing project.

Mullen moved, seconded by Birt, to approve Utility Permit 12-07 for SIRWA and Utility Permit 12-08 for SIRWA. Ayes: Birt, Mullen, Peckham, McCarty. Nays: none. England abstained from Utility Permit 12-07 and voted aye for Utility Permit 12-08. Motion carried.

No action was taken regarding filling a vacancy on the Board of Health.

Peckham moved, seconded by Mullen to approve the IDPH Contract #588 3 SS02. Ayes: Birt, Mullen, Peckham, McCarty, England. Nays: none. Motion carried.

The supervisors discussed repairs vs. replacement for the courthouse boiler system. After a review of gas usage, estimated repair costs, and replacement costs, Mullen moved, seconded by Peckham, to move forward with repairing the tubes, removing the asbestos and reinsulating at an estimated cost of \$21,785. Ayes: Birt, Mullen, Peckham, McCarty, England. Nays: none. Motion carried.

A request for burial funds was discussed. McCarty moved, seconded by Birt, to approve payment as requested. Ayes: Birt, Mullen, Peckham, McCarty, England. Nays: none. Motion carried.
