

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, July 24, 2012, with the following members answering roll call: Linda England, Karl McCarty, Jerry Peckham and Phyllis Mullen. Supervisor Birt was absent. The meeting was called to order by Chair. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

The Supervisors discussed the Safety Committee's recommendation to require a written response from a department that has received notice of a safety concern for correction. Peckham moved, seconded by McCarty, to approve the recommendation. Ayes: Mullen, Peckham, McCarty, England. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Following a review of a SICOG GAP Program Confidentiality Agreement, Mullen moved, seconded by Peckham, to approve the agreement. Ayes: Mullen, Peckham, McCarty, England. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Pat Hass, Spring Lake Villas, and Larry Goldberg of Goldberg, Sullivan & McCreery, Inc. presented information relating to a proposed 36-unit assisted living facility. They suggested a public/private partnership with the issuance of revenue bonds. No votes were taken.
