

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, August 7, 2012, with the following members answering roll call: Linda England, Phyllis Mullen, Karl McCarty, Jerry Peckham and Doug Birt. The meeting was called to order by Chair. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Adams County Treasurer Nancy Kempton discussed the title of a 1991 mobile home in Pottawattamie County. No votes were taken.

Mullen moved, seconded by Birt to approve Utility Permit 12-09 for SIRWA. Ayes: Birt, Peckham, McCarty, England, Mullen. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Peckham moved, seconded by Mullen to approve Utility Permit 12-10 for SIRWA. Ayes: Birt, Peckham, McCarty, England, Mullen. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Following a review of bids, McCarty moved, seconded by Birt, to approve the purchase of a 2013 ½ ton Ford pickup with extended cab and four-wheel drive for \$25,195 from Creston Automotive. Ayes: England, Mullen, Birt, Peckham, McCarty. Nays: none. Motion carried. The pickup will be used by Secondary Roads.

County Engineer Eldon Rike discussed the need to close and replace a bridge in Section 31 of Nodaway Township. Because the bridge spans the Nodaway River and is on the county line, Taylor County has agreed to pay for half of the expense. No votes were taken.

Supervisor Peckham left the meeting at 9:30 AM.

Mullen moved, seconded by Birt, to approve the renewal of NPDES Discharge Permit #0200900. Ayes: England, Mullen, Birt, McCarty. Nays: none. Motion carried.

A written monthly report from the Adams County Recorder was read and approved. Written reports by the Supervisors were submitted as follows: Phyllis Mullen – RCD in Creston on August 2 at 6:30 PM and Main Street Organization Committee on August 6 at 4:00 PM.
