The Board of Supervisors, under the authority of the 2011 Code of Iowa, formed a canvassing board to check the returns of the General Election held on November 6, 2012. The findings, thereof, are recorded at length in Election Book No. 8 in the Adams County Auditor's Office as required by Section 50.27 of the 2011 Code of Iowa. Pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 50.22, eleven Provisional Ballots were received and all were counted except one; there were also 4 additional absentee ballots counted. Mullen moved, seconded by Birt, to approve Utility Permit 12-19 for Farmers Mutual Telephone Company. Ayes: Dixon, Birt, Mullen, McCarty, England. Nays: none. Motion carried.

The Annual TIF report was tabled.

Eldon Rike presented a proposed administrative settlement determination between Adams County and BNSF Railroad. He cited having hired an appraiser for the process of acquiring temporary and permanent easements for the 5.54 acre access to complete a bridge reconstruction project BRS-C002(55)—60-02. Mullen moved, seconded by Dixon to approve the proposed settlement amount of \$14,900 to BNSF. Ayes: Dixon, Birt, Mullen, McCarty, England. Nays: none. Motion carried.
