

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, January 29, 2013, with the following members present: Chairperson, Douglas Birt; Merlin Dixon; Linda England; Karl McCarty; and Phyllis Mullen.

England moved, seconded by McCarty, to approve a Fuel & Gas Contract with UFMC effective January 1, 2013, through December 31, 2013. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. A complete copy of the contract is on file in the Adams County Engineer's Office and is open to public inspection during regular business hours.

A Department Head Meeting was held with Tom Williams. No action was taken.

Budget requests were presented by Vicki Hodge for Rural Iowa Crisis Center, Lori Nosekabel for Mental Health, and Kris Richey for Case Management.

A discussion was held with Dan Carl regarding the Timber Ridge Project. No action was taken. There was discussion of the DECAT 28E Agreement. No action was taken.

Mullen moved, seconded by McCarty, to set a public hearing on February 12, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. in the supervisors' boardroom in the Adams County Courthouse in Corning, IA, for Proposed Paving Project FM-C002( )—5F-02 on Brooks Road commencing at the Avenue of Industries then west approximately 1,760 ft. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Maen Haddadin MD was appointed to the Board of Health to replace Steven Gruba MD. An appointment for the Zoning Commission was tabled.
