

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, May 7, 2013, with the following members answering roll call: Linda England, Karl McCarty, Merlin Dixon and Doug Birt. Phyllis Mullen was absent. The meeting was called to order by the Chair. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Dixon moved, seconded by England, to cancel the Public Hearing for the Budget amendment. Each department concluded that they would stay within their proposed budget; therefore, there was no need to amend. Ayes: Birt, England, McCarty, Dixon. Nays: none. Motion carried.

McCarty moved, seconded by Dixon, to approve the permit for Midlands Pyrotechnics Association to hold a fireworks display at Shafer Farms for May 10-11, 2013. Ayes: Birt, England, McCarty, Dixon. Nays: none. Motion carried.

McCarty moved, seconded by England, to approve the SIRWA Building Permit Application 13-1. Ayes: Birt, England, McCarty, Dixon. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Discussion was held with Jim Whitmore and Pam Haley with Okey Vernon in regard to how the County's Warrant Process goes through the bank. No action was taken. The supervisors reviewed and accepted the Recorder's Report of Fees Collected.

England moved, seconded by McCarty, to pay the Data Plan for Stan Grebner's cell phone allowance. Ayes: Birt, England, McCarty, Dixon. Nays: none. Motion carried.
