

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, August 6, 2013, with the following members present: Linda England; Doug Birt; Karl McCarty; Merlin Dixon; and Phyllis Mullen. The meeting was called to order by the Chair. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

McCarty moved, seconded by Mullen, to offer in two payments \$48,000 for improvements made to the marina to Colony Concessions, Inc. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Jayne Templeton discussed the Blue Cross Blue Shield requirements and the compliance of Adams County's Insurance Policy. No action was taken.

Mike Miltner presented the Board with a refund check from Iowa Communities Assurance Pool for the amount of \$9,001.71.
