

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, August 27, 2013, with the following members present: Linda England; Karl McCarty; Doug Birt; Phyllis Mullen; and Merlin Dixon. The meeting was called to order by the Chair. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

There were discussions held regarding bringing sewer from Lake Icaria and Country Haven to the Corning Lagoon. People attending and giving input were; Dan Carl, Guy Brace, Carl Goodson and Al Peckham. No action was taken.

Mullen moved, seconded by McCarty, to approve Resolution No. 08272013A, to put up stop signs at 150<sup>th</sup> St. and Quince Ave., and Resolution No. 08272013B, to remove a stop sign at 170<sup>th</sup> St. and Poplar Ave. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. The full resolutions are available in the Auditor's office during regular business hours.

McCarty moved, seconded by England, to approve Right-of-Way Purchase Agreement Project BROS-C087(49) – 8J-87 between Adams County and John F. and Susan G. Kuehl; James S. and Linda A Kuehl; and Paul M. and Marilyn Kuehl.

Discussions were held with HR Green regarding Country Haven's Lagoon and the submittal of the proposal to the DNR to make the lagoon compliant.
