

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, October 29, 2013, with the following members present: Linda England; Phyllis Mullen; Doug Birt; and Merlin Dixon. Karl McCarty was absent. The meeting was called to order by the Chair. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

England moved, seconded by Mullen, to approve the Utility Permit Application for SIRWA, permit number 13-3. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

England moved, seconded by Mullen, to approve an update to the Sheriff Department's handbook on benefit eligibility to "The first of the month following 60 calendar days". All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Alan Johannes was present to discuss the jail, but this was tabled for another meeting.

Ryan Potts with Liberty National Life gave a presentation on their supplemental insurance benefit packages. No action was taken.

There was a discussion on the options for fixing the lagoon out at Lake Icaria. No action was taken.

Wes Ray had a discussion on a provider for the Ag Layer on our GIS system. It was decided a meeting should be held with the Assessor's Conference Board on November 14 at 6:00 pm.
