

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, February 18, 2014, with the following members present: Linda England; Phyllis Mullen; Merlin Dixon;; and Doug Birt. Karl McCarty was absent. The meeting was called to order by the Chair. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

England moved, seconded by Birt, to approve the Frontier Communications Utility Permit Number 14-1. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Birt moved, seconded by Mullen, to approve moving line items FICA, IPERS, and Insurance in the budget for a deputy from the Special Law Enforcement Fund to the General Supplemental Fund starting July 1, 2014. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

There was discussion on a phone issue and the prisoners, and the issue has been resolved.

Dan Carl and Al Peckham gave an update on the Lake Icaria Sewer Project. They have a price for the engineering work that will need to be done from HR Green.

Jason Swanson wasn't present for his request to be paid out for comp time. No action was taken.
