

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, March 18, 2014, with the following members present: Linda England; Phyllis Mullen; Merlin Dixon; Karl McCarty; and Doug Birt. The meeting was called to order by the Chair. Mullen moved, seconded by England, to amend the agenda to add approval of the Cost Advisory Agreement. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Jayne Templeton gave an update on the county's health insurance policy. She reported there was a 0% increase for the upcoming year. England moved, seconded by Mullen, to accept the new year's proposal at the same rate. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

McCarty moved, seconded by Birt, to approve the three-year renewal contract agreement for Cost Advisory Services Inc to provide cost allocation services for the county. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

There was discussion on Southern Hills Mental Health Region's 28E Agreement. The supervisors asked to have the wording in two paragraphs more definitive in the agreement before they would sign the agreement. England will take this to the region's CPC Board.

England moved, seconded by Birt, to approve Resolution No. 03182014 to change the full-time Adams County Attorney position from full-time to a part-time effective April 1, 2014. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.
