Max Elg from Solutions met with the board and county officials to discuss concerns regarding the ISeries Computer System. Following discussion, England moved, seconded by Birt, to purchase this system for a cost of \$28,402.36. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

The Corning Public Library Report was read and approved.
