

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Tuesday, June 10, 2014, with the following members present: Karl McCarty; Doug Birt; Linda England, and Merlin Dixon. Phyllis Mullen was absent. The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Dixon. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

At 9:00 am, the Board of Supervisors proceeded to canvass the results of the votes of the 2014 Primary Election held on June 3, 2014. No obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass. In accordance with 50.22 of the Code of Iowa, the Commissioner announced that there were 3 special ballots rejected and not counted. A total of 468 people voted in Adams County at the Primary Election on June 3. Candidates nominated by the Republican Party were: Adams County District 1 Supervisor – Doug Birt, Adams County District 3 Supervisor – Linda C. England, Adams County District 4 Supervisor – Leland D. Shipley, Adams County Recorder – Jamie Stargell. Candidates nominated by the Democratic Party were: Adams County District 1 Supervisor – Larry Sawyer, Adams County District 3 Supervisor – Kevin L. Wynn, Adams County District 4 Supervisor – Tyler Edwards, Adams County Treasurer – Nancy Kempton, Adams County Recorder – Iona M. Allen, Adams County Attorney – Andrew J. Zimmerman, There were no candidates nominated by the Republican Party for County Treasurer or County Attorney.

McCarty moved, seconded by Birt, to approve the Solutions Support Agreement and Statement of Work. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

England moved, seconded by Birt, to approve the Williamson American Legion Post #719 Liquor License # LA0000576. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

McCarty moved, seconded by Birt, to approve Eldon Rike's Employment Contract and Agreement. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.
