

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met at 1:00 pm on Tuesday, August 26, 2014, with the following members present: Karl McCarty; Doug Birt, Linda England, and Merlin Dixon. Phyllis Mullen was absent. The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Dixon. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Birt moved, seconded by England to approve the final progress voucher Brooks Paving Project. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Eldon Rike, Donnie Ashenfelter and Larry Maeder were present at the meeting bringing forth a Secondary Roads Union Grievance. Larry Maeder sprayed an herbicide to eradicate roadside weeds and wanted the \$2.00/hr additional pay it states in the contract for spraying time. Eldon Rike used past precedence where they paid the \$2.00/hr for spraying a chemical that needed a license to spray. The chemical Maeder was using did not need a license to spray. Ashenfelter and Maeder stated their intent in the contract for the extra pay is for exposure to chemicals nothing to do with being licensed. McCarty moved, seconded by England, to pay the additional \$2.00/hr wages to Larry Maeder. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Birt moved, seconded by McCarty, to approve Resolution #08262014A Petitioning and Requesting the Issuance of General County Purpose General Obligation Bonds or Notes, not to exceed the amount of \$1,300,000.00. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

England moved, seconded by Birt, to approve Resolution #08262014B to accept the Engagement Letter from Ahler's & Cooney, PC
