

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 am on Tuesday, September 30, 2014, with the following members present: Karl McCarty; Doug Birt, Linda England, Phyllis Mullen, and Merlin Dixon. The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Dixon. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Carl Goodson gave an update on the Country Haven lagoon and the non-compliance with it. He said we need to discharge, but have to purchase some sodium nitrate to become compliant enough to discharge.

The public Land Auction started at 10:00 am with the following present: Duane Lauer, Matt Herring, and Ryan Schaffer. The auction was for the 103.6 acres of crop ground for which the previous renter didn't want to renew his contract. The bid was awarded to Matt Herring for \$350/ac.
