

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 am on Tuesday, December 16, 2014, with the following members present: Doug Birt, Linda England, Merlin Dixon, and Karl McCarty. Phyllis Mullen was absent. The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Dixon. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

The board approved the monthly fees collected report presented by Recorder Miller for August, September, October, and November.
