

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 am on Tuesday, March 17, 2015, with the following members present: Doug Birt, Linda England, Leland Shipley, Merlin Dixon, and Karl McCarty. The meeting was called to order by the Chair, McCarty. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Auditor Bissell discussed with the board the need for the transfer books and the old plat books to be restored and protected for future use. Some of the books are in bad shape and Auditor Bissell is applying for grants to preserve historical records. The board agreed that the auditor's office could pursue finding and applying for grants to help with the costs.

Birt moved, seconded by Dixon to approve the Mental Health Advocate Costs. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Andrew Zimmerman discussed during a Code of Ordinance work session the different chapters he was recommending to edit.

Birt moved, seconded by Shipley to award the 2015 Rock Resurfacing bid to Schildberg Construction Co., Inc. Total tons are 55,215 for a total cost of \$916,646.71. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.
