

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 am on Thursday, December 10, 2015, with the following members present: Leland Shipley, Doug Birt, Linda England, and Merlin Dixon. Karl McCarty was absent. The meeting was called to order by the Vice Chairperson England. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Stan Grebner presented the board with the diesel fuel contracts from FS and UFMC. Birt moved, seconded by Dixon to approve signing a one year contract with FS. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Dixon moved, seconded by Shipley to approve Resolution 2015-34 the budgeted transfer of funds from Local Option fund 17000 to the Aquatic Center Fund 17002 for the amount of \$92,055.00. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.
