

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 am on Tuesday, January 19, 2016, with the following members present: Karl McCarty, Linda England, Doug Birt, Leland Shipley, and Merlin Dixon. The meeting was called to order by the Chairperson England. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

McCarty moved, seconded by Shipley to approve Utility Permit #16-01 for Mediacom Communication Data Link. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Dixon moved, seconded by Shipley to approve Utility Permit #16-02 for SIRWA. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Birt moved, seconded by Shipley to approve the Semi Annual Treasurer Report presented by Treasurer Nancy Kempton. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Treasurer Kempton presented the Treasurer Department budget for FY 16/17. She requested giving clerk Holly Schafer a raise to \$15.12 /hr. McCarty moved, seconded by Birt to approve the \$15.12/hr wage for Holly starting July 1, 2016. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Various budgets were presented to the board from the following departments: Public Health – Kathy West, Adams County Soil & Water Conservation – Bill Shipley, Lara Schenck, and Doug Davenport, and 4-H – Patrick Hogan and Chris Nelson.

The board of supervisors discussed with employees their desire to streamline the payroll process throughout the entire county. The board asked the department heads and employees to bring forth any complaints or issues they have. The following members were present; Sheriff Alan Johannes, Secondary Roads Crew Darwin Shires and Donnie Ashenfelter, Treasurer Nancy Kempton, and Auditor Becky Bissell and Deputy Auditor Jen Shires. Concerns were expressed about changing the payroll and being a burden on the employees. The board gave a 6 month notice to all employees stating the change will occur July 1, 2016. Donnie Ashenfelter gave feedback along with a possible revised plan. The board took in all the concerns and issues and will work toward a solution to affect the least amount of employees while still streamlining payroll and get away from paying live. No action has been taken at this time.
