

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 am on Tuesday, May 31, 2016, with the following members present: Karl McCarty, Linda England, Leland Shipley, Merlin Dixon, and Doug Birt. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson England. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Birt moved, seconded by McCarty to approve donating the budgeted \$2,500 plus \$1,500 for a total of \$4,000 to Hearts and Hugs Daycare for the next three years to help with the renovations to the new building. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Shipley moved, seconded by Birt to approve the firework permit for Shafer Farm on June 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Shipley moved, seconded by McCarty to approve the liquor license for Backpocket Brewing, LLC during RAGBRAI. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Sandra Leininger gave an update on submitting the Historical Preservation Report to the state. She also gave an update on the Icarian Projects. The community kitchen is fully complete now that the septic system is in place. This summer's project is to construct the outhouses.

The board members met at the Memorial Rock Park where Governor Branstad and Lieutenant Governor Reynolds declared Adams County and the City of Corning as Home Base Iowa Communities. This is a program to provide incentives for veterans to settle in our community.

Oral committee reports by the supervisors were given as follows: Dixon – E911 in Creston at 7:30 pm on May 25; and McCarty – Heartland Alliance in Creston at 5:00 pm on May 26 and Hospital Board in Corning at 11:30 am on May 26.
