

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 am on Tuesday, June 14, 2016, with the following members present: Leland Shipley, Merlin Dixon, Karl McCarty and Doug Birt. Linda England was absent. The meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairperson Shipley. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Birt moved, seconded by McCarty to approve a Temporary Liquor License for Backpocket Brewing on Quince Avenue during RAGBRAI. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Dixon moved, seconded by Birt to approve liquor license LA0000576 for the Williamson Legion. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Birt moved, McCarty seconded approval of the ICAP insurance renewal increasing the liability amount from \$4,000,000 to \$5,000,000. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

McCarty moved, seconded by Dixon to approve Resolution #2016-12 placing appointment of Township Officers for Grant Township on the November 8, 2016, General Election Ballot. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

A Public Hearing will be held on June 28, 2016, to purchase of a new software program for the Sheriff’s Department that will be at 0% interest over two fiscal years.

Birt moved, seconded by Dixon to approve Utility Permit 16-07 for Cumberland Telephone Company. This will affect the K road for 1.5 miles.

Discussion was held on the forfeiture of unused vacation with secondary roads. The board will continue to follow the current policy as listed in the handbook.

McCarty moved, seconded with Dixon approve signing Stan Grebner’s Employment contract for FY 16/17.

Discussion was held on the possibility of a group requesting to read the Bible in front of the courthouse.

The board heard a presentation from Colonial Life Insurance Company.

The Board of Supervisors proceeded to canvass the results of the votes of the 2016 Primary Election held on June 7, 2016. No obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass. A total of 259 people voted in Adams County at the Primary Election on June 7. Candidates nominated by the Republican Party were: Adams County District 5 Supervisor – Karl McCarty, Adams County Auditor – Rebecca Bissell, Adams County Sheriff – Alan Johannes. There were no candidates nominated by the Republican Party for County Supervisor District 2 or County Attorney (to fill a vacancy). Candidates nominated by the Democratic Party were: Adams County District 2 Supervisor – Merlin R. Dixon. There were no candidates nominated by the Democratic Party for County Supervisor District 5, County Auditor, County Sheriff or County Attorney (to fill a vacancy).
