

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 am on Tuesday, October 25, 2016, with the following members present: Linda England, Leland Shipley, and Doug Birt. Merlin Dixon and Karl McCarty were absent. Also in attendance were Engineer Eldon Rike, Roads Supervisor Stan Grebner, Ronda Russell, Auditor Becky Bissell, Conservation Park Officer Travis Paul, and Treasurer Nancy Kempton. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson England.

Joan Gallagher with Taylor County Public Health gave an update on the consolidation of the Adams County Public Health and the office here in Corning. Joan informed the board that the branch office located in the CHI Wellness Center is now open and fully staffed. They will be hosting an open house on November 8<sup>th</sup> starting at 10:30 a.m. The board thanked Joan for all her hard work during this transitional period.

Birt moved, seconded by Shipley to approve hiring a new Maintenance I position for Secondary Roads. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Auditor Bissell discussed with the board the need to contact Ahlers and Cooney about a resolution concerning the additional bond payments for the Aquatic Center due to the City of Corning paying off their portion of the debt. Setting a public hearing for an ordinance regarding flood areas was tabled.

Ronda Russell informed the board that she had applied for an E911 grant to help with the cost of new radios being purchased by the Sheriff’s department. The grant was approved so the board will pay the total cost of \$14,042.05 and then will be reimbursed 50% from the grant funds.

A department head meeting was held and updates were given by the following departments: Conservation, Secondary Roads, Treasurer, and Auditor.

The board discussed putting together a security committee to work on updating the Courthouse Security Policies and Procedures. Birt volunteered to sit on the committee.
