

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 am on Tuesday, November 29, 2016, with the following members present: Linda England, Leland Shipley, Doug Birt, Merlin Dixon and Karl McCarty. Also in attendance was Adams County Sheriff Alan Johannes. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson England.

Sheriff Johannes presented to the board information regarding the cost of improving the security of the dispatch area in the courthouse. The renovations would total approximately \$13,000. Doug Birt moved, seconded by Leland Shipley to approve the project using \$10,000 from the LOST fund and the remaining amount to be funded by General Basic – Central Services. The sheriff will look for grant funds to reduce the amount funded by the General Basic account.

Family Farm Tax Credit applications were presented to the board and they were approved or denied.

Committee Reports by the supervisors were given as follows: Dixon, ACEDC, Corning, November 22; Birt, Crossroads, November 28, Creston.
