

Board Minutes March 21, 2017

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Tuesday, March 21, 2017, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Doug Birt, Merlin Dixon, Linda England, Karl McCarty, and Leland Shipley. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Shipley. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Joan Gallagher, Taylor County Public Health, discussed with the board a possible agreement to have Taylor County Public Health provide public health and home care aide services to residents of Adams County. There is also a need to appoint someone to serve on the Board of Health. The issue was tabled.

Eldon Rike, County Engineer, discussed with the board the plan by Schildberg's concerning the Rock Quarry Road. They will keep the board informed as the project moves along.

Birt moved, seconded by England to accept the low bid of \$1,026,525.73 by Schildberg for rock. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.

The board travelled to the former Country Haven site to explore the property. Birt moved, seconded by England to donate the three compartment sink from the kitchen to the City of Corning for their use. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.
