

Board Minutes March 28, 2017

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Tuesday, March 28, 2017, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Doug Birt, Merlin Dixon, Linda England, Karl McCarty, and Leland Shipley. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Shipley. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

England moved, seconded by Birt to publish the Final Ordinances at a date determined by Auditor Bissell and Andrew Zimmerman.

The board received the Hazardous Material Inventory Report for Country Haven from HR Green along with a bid for abatement. The board requested from HR Green more bids on the abatement process.

Birt moved, seconded by McCarty to appoint Dr. Ryan Shuey to replace Hartford Cooper on the Board of Health. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.

McCarty moved, seconded by England to approve the agreement for Taylor County Public Health to provide public health and home care aide services to residents of Adams County. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.

Birt moved, seconded by Dixon to move the custodian and maintenance positions under the supervision of the Auditor's office. This came to light in the process of reviewing county job descriptions and the supervisory positions. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.
