

Board Minutes April 18, 2017

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Tuesday, April 18, 2017, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Doug Birt, Merlin Dixon, Linda England, Karl McCarty, and Leland Shipley. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Shipley. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Dixon moved, seconded by Birt to approve the Recorder's Quarterly Report as presented by Jamie Stargell. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.

England moved, seconded by Birt to approve the fireworks permit for Adams County Fair and Racing Association scheduled for June 24th with a rain date set for July 1st. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.

Paul Anstey discussed with the board the Fair Board's desire to have a parade in Corning to kick off the fair this summer. The board said they support the idea, but that it was up to the Corning City Council to approve the route.

McCarty moved, seconded by England to temporarily close County Route H54 from Apple Ave and east one half mile for construction of Bridge Replacement Project BRS-C002 (55) - - 60-02. The detour shall commence at the intersection of W 3rd Street and U Avenue in Villisca; North on U Avenue to High Street; West on High Street to US Hwy 34 to Adams County Route N26; South on N26 to Adams County Route H54 and terminating there. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.

England moved, seconded by Birt to approve Resolution 2017-10 Establishing 2017 Noxious Weed Control for Adams County. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.

Committee reports were presented by the Supervisors as follows: Shipley – Home Base IA, Corning, April 12, Main Street, Corning, April 11, and Main Street ER, Corning, April 12; Dixon – Home Base IA, Corning, April 12; and Birt – ACCS, Corning, April 13 and Conservation, Corning, April 13.
