

Board Minutes May 9, 2017

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Tuesday, May 9, 2017, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Doug Birt, Merlin Dixon, Linda England, Karl McCarty, and Leland Shipley. Also in attendance were Eldon Rike, Stan Grebner, Andy Knuth, Alan Johannes, and Mark Saylor. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Shipley. McCarty moved, seconded by England to amend the agenda to add appointment of RLF Loan Committee to 10:15 am. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

England moved, seconded by McCarty to approve the final progress voucher asphalt resurfacing project STP-S-C002 (71)- 5E-02. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.

Stan Grebner updated the board on bids he's been receiving for new dump trucks and snow equipment. He didn't have any final numbers but hopefully by next meeting he'd have something to present the board.

McCarty moved, seconded by England to approve a quote for asbestos removal from the agricultural buildings at the county care facility. Bockmann Inc. was awarded the job in the amount of \$10,250 and will have three days to complete the project. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.

England moved, seconded by Birt to approve Resolution 2017-11 fixing date for a meeting on the proposition of the application of excess note proceeds and providing for publication of notice. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.

McCarty moved, seconded by Birt to appoint Linda England to the SICOG Adams County Revolving Loan Fund Loan Committee. All supervisors voted aye, motion carried.

County Attorney Andy Knuth and Sheriff Alan Johannes discussed with the board the need to change a security camera that is in the courtroom and discussed the legislative changes that go in effect July 1, 2017 regarding permit to carry in public buildings.
