

Board Minutes October 16, 2017

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, October 16, 2017, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Merlin Dixon, Linda England, Doug Birt, and Leland Shipley. Karl McCarty was absent. Also in attendance were Stan Grebner, Travis Paul, Andy Knuth, and Mark Saylor. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Shipley. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

England moved, seconded by Birt to approve clarifying language in the Handbook's Vacation Policy. The supervisors are not changing the way the policy is implemented, but it was brought to the board's attention that the language might need to be clarified. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.
