

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, January 8, 2018, at 9:00 am with the following members present: Linda England, Leland Shipley, Doug Birt, Merlin Dixon, and Karl McCarty. Also in attendance were Sheriff Alan Johannes, Joan Gallagher, Ivan Wolf, Eric Wolf, Kevin Wynn, and Mark Saylor. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Birt. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

McCarty moved, seconded by England to open the public hearing at 9:00 am to vacate a portion of the Brooks Rd. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. There were no written or oral objections. England moved, seconded by Shipley to close the public hearing at 9:05 am. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

There were no written or oral objections presented to the board. England moved, seconded by Shipley to close the public hearing at 10:05 am. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Public Health budget was presented to the board by Joan Gallagher.

Taylor County Board of Supervisor Chairperson, Doug Horton, called the Adams County Board of Supervisors to discuss the Emergency Districts. Taylor County wants to move the Emergency Districts lines for Ambulances to match the fire district lines instead of by county lines. Sheriff Johannes informed the board that 3-5 years ago Taylor County was the entity that wanted to make the ambulance districts run within county lines. Now, however, Taylor County board recognizes that districts by county lines isn't working and would like to change to having the ambulance districts congruent with the fire districts. Adams County board agreed it should be that way and that any costs associated with changing the district lines back to following the fire districts will be at the expense of Taylor County.

Ron Saltzman addressed the board with more questions regarding the land he is purchasing from the county.

Committee reports were given by the Supervisors as follows: McCarty – RC&D, Jan 4; Dixon – ACEDC Housing, Jan 4; and England – AC Emergency Management, Jan 3.
