

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Tuesday, May 29, 2018 at 9:00 am with the following members present: Linda England, Leland Shipley, Karl McCarty, and Merlin Dixon. Doug Birt was absent. Also in attendance were; Lauri Greenlee, Scott Akin, Mark Saylor, Nancy Kempton, Larry Badgett, Tony Mullen, Eldon Rike, Janice Leonard, Nick Wetzel, Ryan Shuey, Jamie Stargell, Andrew Knuth, Virgil James, and Roger Shindell. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Birt. The agenda for the day was read and approved. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Nick Wetzel and Ryan Shuey discussed with the board their desire to develop some land as a potential subdivision and would like the board to consider putting in a road. The board asked Engineer Eldon Rike to look into what the cost would be for constructing such road.

Shipley moved, seconded by Dixon to approve an agreement with Union County to use their Engineer's services as needed to fill in if the county is still without an engineer following Eldon Rike's retirement on June 30, 2018. Adams County moved to pay Union County Engineer's Office for services at a rate of \$70/hour and \$.50/mile to Union County. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

McCarty moved, seconded by Dixon to accept Engineer Eldon Rike's retirement letter effective June 30, 2018. All supervisors voted to accept his resignation with regret and with thanks for his many years of service to the county. Motion carried.

Discussion was held with Adams County Weed Commissioner, Virgil James, regarding a complaint from Larry Badgett. Andrew Knuth spoke with the board regarding the concerns. The board asked Virgil to contact Rick Schafer to spray and take care of the Badgett property and the Gillet property. Larry Badgett also has concerns with the Weed Commissioner's report.

Roger Shindell with Carosh Compliance Solutions spoke with the board regarding the County's HIPAA compliance policies and procedures.

Committee reports were given by the Supervisors as follows: McCarty – Heartland Alliance, May 24, Creston; and England – Southern Hills Regional Mental Health, Corning, May 25, and CHI Hospital Board, Corning, May 24.
