

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Tuesday, June 12, 2018 at 1:00 pm with the following members present: Linda England, Leland Shipley, Karl McCarty, Doug Birt, and Merlin Dixon. Also in attendance were; Lisa Wolfe, Jan Beach-Sickles, Andy Lauritsen, Lisa Brown, Tony Mullen, Scott Akin, Nancy Kempton, Alan Johannes, Karl Herring, Nancy Turner and Mark Saylor. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Birt. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Lisa Wolf, Jan Beach-Sickles and Andy Lauritsen discussed with the board issues concerning the county ambulances. Currently both ambulances have blown engines. They have already started the process to replace one of the engines, but want input from the board as to what to do with the other one. They presented pros and cons on fixing the engine or replacing the ambulance.

The board recognized Ramon Haley for his 35 years of service to Adams County Secondary Roads.

Shipley moved, seconded by Dixon to approve Liquor License LA0000576 for the Williamson American Legion Post #719. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Shipley moved, seconded by McCarty to approve Roseanne Sychra as the Colony Township Clerk. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

McCarty moved, seconded by Shipley to approve Hairball's Firework permit for July 9th at the Adams County Speedway during the Adams County 4-H/FFA Fair. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

The Board of Supervisors proceeded to canvass the results of the votes of the 2018 Primary Election held on June 5, 2018. No obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass and there were no special ballots that were rejected and not counted. A total of 572 votes were cast in Adams County at the Primary Election on June 5th. Candidates nominated by the Republican Party were: Adams County Board of Supervisor District 1 – Douglas Birt, Adams County Board of Supervisor District 3 – Scott Akin, Adams County Board of Supervisor District 4 – Leland Shipley, County Attorney – Andrew Knuth, County Recorder – Jamie Stargell. Candidates nominated by the Democratic Party were: Adams County Board of Supervisor District 1 – Marty Olive, Adams County Board of Supervisor District 3 – Tony Mullen, County Treasurer – Nancy Barnes. There were no candidates nominated by the Republican Party for County Treasurer. There were no candidates nominated by the Democratic Party for Adams County Supervisor District 4, County Attorney or County Recorder. There were no candidate nominated by the Libertarian Party for any county positions.
