

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, October 8, 2018 at 9:00 am with the following members present: Linda England, Merlin Dixon, Karl McCarty, and Leland Shipley. Doug Birt was absent. Also in attendance were Alan Johannes, Scott Akin, Tony Mullen, Nancy Barnes, Jamie Stargell, Robert Walter, Clarissa Walter, Jason Green, Mark Zaccone, Matt Ott, Bart Knox, Aaron Inman, Alvin Inman, and Lynne Inman. The meeting was called to order by Vice Chairperson England. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Treasurer Nancy Barnes discussed with the board the possibility of investing with IPAIT (Iowa Public Agency Investment Trust). She said the rates have been low in the past but now interest rates are going up so Barnes is wanting to join. Shipley moved, Dixon seconded to approve investing with IPAIT. All Supervisors voted aye. Motion passed.

Engineer Travis Malone discussed purchasing a 1988 Semi for \$18,000. He also presented the board with 4 quotes for a triple axel belly dump trailer for hauling larger loads of rock and sand. He recommended the ITM trailer for \$48,650. McCarty moved, seconded by Dixon to purchase the 1988 Semi and the ITM trailer. All Supervisors voted aye. Motion passed.

McCarty moved, seconded by Shipley to open the public hearing at 10:00 am. All Supervisors voted aye. Motion passed. There were no written objections. Jason Green discussed that he doesn't want to have any wind turbines in Adams County and definitely doesn't want any in and around his area. Alvin Inman doesn't want them either. Clarissa Walter spoke as well in disapproving of the windmills. There were no oral objections for the current ordinances as presented. The group were requesting the board research increasing the separation distance of windmill placement in the county. Dixon moved, seconded by McCarty to close the public hearing at 10:45 am.

McCarty moved, seconded by Dixon to approve Ordinance 2018-1 Adopting the Proposed Code of Ordinances of Adams County, Iowa, as the 2018 County Code of the County of Adams, Iowa, as revised and reordered effective as of today, October 8, 2018, and to waive the second and third reading. All Supervisors voted aye. Motion passed.
