

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, November 19, 2018 at 1:00 pm with the following members present: Linda England, Merlin Dixon, Leland Shipley, Doug Birt, and Karl McCarty. Also in attendance were Scott Akin, Brian Kannas, Travis Paul, Nancy Barnes, Bart Knox, Jan Leonard, Andrew Knuth, Lisa Brown, Joan Gallagher, and Larry Badgett. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Birt. The agenda for the day was read and approved.

Joan Gallagher gave an update on public health and usage numbers for the county. She’s pleased with where the numbers are right now and presented a few anecdotal stories on how home health has benefitted the county and the clients who are using the services.

Conservation Director, Travis Paul, gave an update on the Lake Icaria Cottages. There will be one more payment made of approximately \$56,000.

Brian Kannas, with Robinson Implement, addressed the board and updated them on the services that the company provides and requested that they be included in the future bids for equipment.

Greg Davis with Solutions, Inc. presented the board information regarding changes coming in the future with computers, operating systems, and backup software and the support that will be needed. He wanted the board to be aware of how this would affect budgeting in the future.

Discussion was held regarding the position of Weed Commissioner for the county. The Auditor and Engineer were instructed to research how other counties handle the position and to report back to the Board.

Dixon moved, seconded by Shipley to approve the 28E Agreement with the State of Iowa regarding the Iowa County Attorney’s Case Management Software. All Supervisors voted aye. Motion passed.
