

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, February 11, 2019 at 9:00 am with the following members present: Scott Akin, Merlin Dixon, Leland Shipley, and Doug Birt. Also in attendance were Bart Knox, Nancy Barnes, Travis Malone, Travis Paul, and Jamie Stargell. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Shipley. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the agenda for the day was read and approved.

Engineer Travis Malone presented the Contract Rock Bid Documents to the board.
