

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, June 8, 2019 at 9:00 am with the following members present: Merlin Dixon, Doug Birt, Leland Shipley, Bobbi Maynes, and Scott Akin. Also, in attendance were: Beth Waddle, Alan Johannes, Jan Leonard, Nancy Barnes, Travis Malone, Bart Knox, and Bill Lyddon. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Shipley. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Birt to approve both the agenda and the minutes of the July 1, 2019 meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

During public comments, Beth Waddle informed the Board the Adams County had been redesignated as an Iowa Great Place. She will be moving forward on that and will give the board more information as it becomes available. Jan Leonard, Corning Mayor, discussed with the board an issue involving abandoned dogs in the city and whether the county had ever looked into providing animal rescue services.

County Engineer Malone informed the board of his meeting with FEMA later today to discuss mitigation and also that the design proposals for two of the flood damaged bridges will coming in by the end of the month. Regarding resurfacing of Hunter Trail contact has been made with Blacktop Services and Secondary Roads and Blacktop Services will inform the public two weeks prior to road work beginning there.

Dixon moved, seconded by Birt to appoint Bill Lyddon, Emergency Management Director to the South Central Iowa 911 Service Board. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. Bill informed the board that we are eligible for mosquito control with some matching funding from the state.

Maynes moved, seconded by Dixon to approve signing the documents relating to the Rural Business Development Grant. Birt, Maynes, Dixon and Shipley voted aye. Akin abstained. Motion carried.

Birt moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the Joint City/County Agreement for the Development Plan with Corning Hotel, LLC. Birt, Maynes, Dixon and Shipley voted aye. Akin abstained. Motion carried.

Birt moved, seconded by Dixon to accept the resignation of Marcia Cerven from the Planning and Zoning Commission with thanks for her service. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. A discussion of the need for an appointee was discussed.

Alan Johannes reported to the Board that officers are now equipped with NARCAN and that the department's tasers are being updated. The Board toured the Sheriff's department new kitchen improvements.
