

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, August 19, 2019 at 9:00 am with the following members present: Merlin Dixon, Leland Shipley, Doug Birt, Scott Akin and Bobbi Maynes. Also in attendance were: Nancy Barnes, Bill Lyddon, Alan Johannes, Nancy Barnes, Jamie Stargell, Bert Peckham, Jan Leonard, Ben Mullen, Travis Malone, Travis Paul, and Bart Knox. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Shipley. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Maynes to approve today's agenda and the minutes from August 15, 2019. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Travis Malone presented a contract with Calhoun Burns for survey and design of FEMA projects on Aspen Ave. and 190th Street. Birt moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the contract for Calhoun Burns and Associates Consulting services on the aforementioned FEMA projects. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Bill Lyddon discussed with the board the radio quotes for the new state radio system. Akin asked if all of the radios listed were necessary or could the county purchase them as needed. Maynes stated when she looked at the price tag of the quote, she couldn't help but wonder if this is a wish list and she would like Bill to go back to the entities and ask what they have to have but she doesn't want to put anyone's life at risk. Lyddon said he'd go back to the entities to see what their actual need is but recommends we purchase the radios at the same time in order to keep the discounts and to make sure every entity is able to communicate with each other and dispatch for safety concerns.

The following departments gave updates on their departments: Emergency Management, Assessor, Recorder, Treasurer, Conservation, Sheriff, and Auditor.
