

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Wednesday, October 30, 2019 at 10:00 am for a presentation by the City of Corning to the Adams County Board of Supervisors and the Quincy Township Trustees. The desire of the City of Corning is to annex those specific parcels of Corning into the city limits. There are no current plans for the site at this time.
