

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Thursday, January 2, 2020 at 9:00 am with the following members present: Leland Shipley, Scott Akin, Doug Birt, Bobbi Maynes, and Merlin Dixon. The meeting was called to order by Auditor Becky Bissell. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Birt moved, seconded by Dixon to appoint Scott Akin as the Board Chair for a one-year term. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. Maynes moved, seconded by Dixon to approve today's agenda and the minutes from December 23, 2019. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Engineer Travis Malone presented the Secondary Roads departments FY 20/21 budget and the 5-year plan as posted on the DOT website.

Motion was made by Birt, seconded by Dixon to appoint Bobbi Maynes as Vice Chair for the 2020 Board. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Shipley moved, seconded by Birt to approve Resolution 2020-2 the Master Matrix pursuant to Iowa Code section 459.304(3). All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Dixon moved, seconded by Birt to approve Resolution 2020-3 to transfer \$90,118 from Local Option Fund 17000 to Local Option Sinking Fund 17002 to pay off the Aquatic Center Bond. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Birt moved, seconded by Dixon to approve Resolution 2020-4 Amending the Adams County Ordinance Chapter 21 effective January 2, 2020. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Maynes moved, seconded by Birt to accept Mark Devore's resignation as a Mercer Township Trustee and thank Mark for his many years of service. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.
