

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, June 8, 2020 at 1:00 pm with the following members present: Leland Shipley, Scott Akin, Merlin Dixon, Doug Birt and Bobbi Maynes. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Scott Akin. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Maynes moved, seconded by Dixon to approve today's agenda along with the minutes of the June 1st meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Emergency Management Director Bill Lyddon discussed with the board Adams County is not currently a participant in the National Flood Insurance Program, therefore, Adams County does not qualify for the 10% State Funding for flood emergency. This will affect the EWP Projects that are currently in process.

Birt moved, seconded by Shipley to approve the Contract with Cost Advisory Services for Professional Consulting Services. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Dixon moved, seconded by Shipley to approve Liquor License BC0030855 for Bobbers Down Marina (1730 Juniper Corning Iowa, 50841). All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

The June 2, 2020 Primary Election was Canvassed as follows: No obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass and there were no provisional ballots. A total of 744 votes were cast in Adams County at the Primary Election on June 2, 2020. Candidates nominated by the Republican Party were: County Supervisor District 2 – Tony Hardisty, County Supervisor District 5 – Bobbi J. Baker-Maynes, County Auditor – Becky Bissell, County Sheriff – Alan Johannes. Candidates nominated by the Democratic Party were: County Supervisor District 2 – Merlin R. Dixon. There were no candidates nominated by the Democratic Party for Adams County Supervisor District 5, Adams County Auditor, and Adams County Sheriff.
