

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, August 23, 2021 at 9:00 am with the following members present: Bobbi Maynes, Leland Shipley, Doug Birt, and Scott Akin. Merlin Dixon was absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Maynes and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Akin moved, seconded by Shipley to approve today's agenda along with the minutes from August 16, 2021. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Shipley moved, seconded by Birt to approve the Utility Permit #21-10 for SIRWA on 110th Street in Carl Township. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

County Engineer Travis Malone gave an update on his department. The 180th Street bridge replacement bridge is coming along. Repowering permits are coming in for the wind turbines. Plans for asphaltting next year are beginning.

Sheriff Alan Johannes introduced Jail Inspector Delbert Longley to share his guidance on renovation of the Law Enforcement area of the courthouse. His main concerns were the shared Jailer/Dispatchers positions, Classifications of inmates and the space to keep populations separated, and also the need to build a sally port.
