

## Board Minutes September 11, 2023

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, September 11, 2023, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Leland Shipley, Tony Hardisty, Chris Standley, Scott Akin, and Bobbi Maynes. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Shipley. Shipley asked for a moment of silence to remember all those affected by September 11, 2001. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Standley moved, seconded by Maynes to approve the agenda as presented along with the minutes of September 5<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Secondary Roads update was provided as follows: Purchased a new Hotsy Powerwasher to replace the 24-year-old one. A large load of planks came in to replace bridge decking. Starting to stockpile some gravel before the February deadline when the cost is going up by 5%. Wrapping up Hull Street punch list, Quincy 8 pre-pour meeting is this week and scheduled to pour next week. Union 1 re-opened. Railroad meetings scheduled for every Tuesday at 2 to go over the concerns with the 18 crossings in the County. Talked to Montgomery County on redoing old HWY 34, they aren't interested in doing any more at this time. Tested the base stabilization project and the results weren't what they were hoping for. Replacing concrete panels in bad spots around the county. Meeting with Hungry Canyons last Friday was good. Wednesday and Thursday Engineer will be gone attending a conference.
