Engineer Bechtold gave the Secondary Roads update. Rescheduled CPR training for this week. New truck is supposed to be here this week. Front end loader went down and has been repaired. Logan passed the DOT certification and will now be going to get certified in concrete this week. Having a training on using ArcGIS for surveying. Had several complaints on snow removal. The crew has put in 40 hours of OT this past week. The blower machine was used on old 34 and a couple other areas around the county. BNSF will be here Feb 6th to discuss the bridges in District 5 and hopefully get an agreement. Zoning meeting was held and information is on website. Working on TIF projects. Working on closing out projects.

Darci Alt and Rachel Cecil with Heart of Iowa Community Services discussed with the board that Southern Hills Mental Health Region has voted to join Heart of Iowa Region. They are excited to provide child crisis services and mobile crisis services along with developing more services in the region. They have already been in contact with County Rural Offices of Social Services (CROSS) region to join and this would make the entire region contiguous. Shipley moved, seconded by Standley to wind down the Southern Hills Mental Health Region upon an acceptable 28E agreement to reorganize the Heart of Iowa Region. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Department Head reports were as follows: IT – Working on the new panic button system. Conservation – Allied came down and did some trouble shooting on the sewer system but still needs to work on the air release valves. Held a winter safety meeting with the department. Checked the depth of the lake for ice fishers. The ice thickness is good but always promotes using extreme caution while on ice. Sarah, Marti, and Travis will be attending training this week. Met with JEO about helping with some promotional items for a future project of a Nature Center. Auditor – Working on budgets.
