

Board Minutes February 12, 2024

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, February 12, 2024, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Tony Hardisty, Chris Standley, and Leland Shipley. Supervisors Akin and Maynes were absent. The meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairperson Hardisty. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Standley moved, seconded by Shipley to approve the agenda along with the minutes of February 5th regular meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Secondary Roads Update: A tracker for safety training was shared with the board. Most of the course work can be completed on-line. The crews are working on rocking over by Nodaway and brush clearing along the County K Road. The mechanic is currently out so have contacted John Deere to help with some maintenance. Dale and Logan are working on ranking culverts. Working on getting all the easements needed for Colony 19. The Zoning meeting agenda will be posted today for next week's meeting. The TIF spreadsheet has been updated and approved by the attorney. Have received certification for final completion of the Nodaway RR crossing. There was some damage to the Prescott RR crossing that will need attention by the RR. Working on project closeouts, had a meeting with Carbon, and had an additional meeting with the RR to go over the agreement which is still in progress and is a draft of their ask.

A company is coming to do a solar audit to see if there would be a benefit to help offset the costs of electricity. IT: Finished up the site visit with FMTC regarding the new phone system. FMTC will be here February 28-29 to set up the system. Have received information from Motorola concerning the panic buttons. Treasurer: Office is running smoothly. Auditor: Continued work on budgets. The nomination period for the primary election will open on March 4.
