

Board Minutes February 26, 2024

The Adams County Board of Supervisors met on Monday, February 26, 2024, at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Tony Hardisty, Scott Akin, Chris Standley, and Leland Shipley. Bobbi Maynes was absent. The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Akin. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Hardisty moved, seconded by Standley to approve the agenda as amended adding the final payment of the Weed Commissioner. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried. Shipley moved, seconded by Standley to approve the minutes of February 20th regular meeting. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Secondary Roads Update: Working on brush clearing, hauling rock and sign maintenance. The mechanic is still out. Culvert inventory continues. Met with John Thomas of Hungry Canyons concerning the project on Fig Avenue. There are 2 culverts that need replacing. Attended a Hungry Canyons workshop utilizing the LIDAR system which shows where a streambed has changed over time. Attended a 2-day workshop on Federal Aid Funding. Surveying out at Colony 14 which is one of the TIF projects. No new development with the railroad. Working on developing a list for Purple Wave. Gathered information for SAP (Safety Action Plan) for the grant application. There was a meeting last Monday of the Zoning Board and the next meeting will be March 18.

Standley moved, seconded by Shiplely to approve License Number: LF0000576 for Williamson American Legion Post #719. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Shiplely moved, seconded by Standley to approve Application Number-194963 for Lucky Wife Wine Slushies. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Hardisty moved, seconded by Standley to approve the third and final payment for the Weed Commissioner in the amount of \$2475 for last year's work. All supervisors voted aye. Motion carried.

Department Head Reports: Conservation – Working on getting a new fuel tank after the removal the old underground storage tank. The new Trail Scavenger Hunt has been well received. 2 docks were left in over the winter which were purposed for that and so boats can now get in the lake as there is no ice. Things are moving in the right direction with the sewer system and with Allied. In the end there will be 5 new pumps and 4 rebuilt pumps for the system. Three of the nine still have drainage issues and will be addressing that with the addition of French drains. Secondary Roads helped bring rock and spread rock in needed areas around the lake. A student from Atlantic is working on his Eagle Scout project which will be a kayak launch at the Lakeview Campground. Starting to think about seasonal employees and know of three right now who will be returning. Purchased a cell phone booster for the office which greatly enhanced reception. Attended a DNR meeting where they did a year-end recap of animal populations, etc. IT – Finished up the preliminary work for the panic button system. The new phone system will be installed this Wednesday through Friday. Sheriff – The new SRO officer was introduced, Cameron Ward. The new vehicle is getting outfitted for service. RJ's will be coming to replace a stool. The drug dog will be coming sometime in April and is a German Shorthair. The department is currently fully staffed. Recorder and Treasurer's Offices – Nothing to report. Auditor – Filing for the June primary opens on March 4, working on budgets and the new mailing that needs to go to all property owners per legislation passed last year.
