Department Head Reports: Secondary Roads – Crews are cutting brush and hauling rock. Douglas 11 is closed. Engineer Tech and Assistant to the Engineer will be attending classes, a bridge layer has been added on Beacon, need a new copier, have had a complaint on Juniper Ave and will be potentially working on base stabilization for that area. Have a Hungry Canyon

meeting next week. Have finished contract rock in the SW area and moving to NW area next. Zoning meeting tonight. Conservation – Major water leak under concrete. Lake is very low therefore docks would be unsafe to put in, a lot of boat hazards. Marina can't put boats in. Rebuilt marina wall, old gas tank out of ground and new above ground tank is being delivered. 5 air release valves have been replaced and have 5 more to refurbish. Getting a sewer pump rebuilt and did a prescribed burn. Alan Adkisson took out some trees on the Talty Conservation Area and he is going to donate his time to clearing near the archery range and putting in prairie grass. Auditor – Updated the board on the ISAC conference and legislative issues. Sheriff – The new truck is being upfitted, have a job opening for a deputy, and will be hosting a golf tourney to raise funds for a new K-9.
